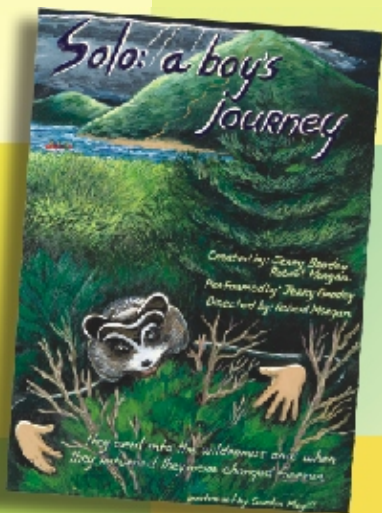

Kim and Jerry Brodey have been singing and using their music with school-aged children since 1979. As dynamic workshop leaders, they have sparked the imaginations of many North American teachers who are searching for new ways to enrich the lives of their students.

Together their range of accomplishments includes eight recordings, five touring stage productions, two video/films, numerous guest recordings, a wide range of supplementary teaching materials and many appearances on television and radio across the country.

Their work has also been nominated for two Junos (in 1996, *Like a Ripple on the Water*, and in 1986, *Family Pie*), a Parents Choice Award (1986's *Family Pie*). In 1983 they have received an American Library Notable Recording Award and an Action For Children's Television Award for Responsible Programming.

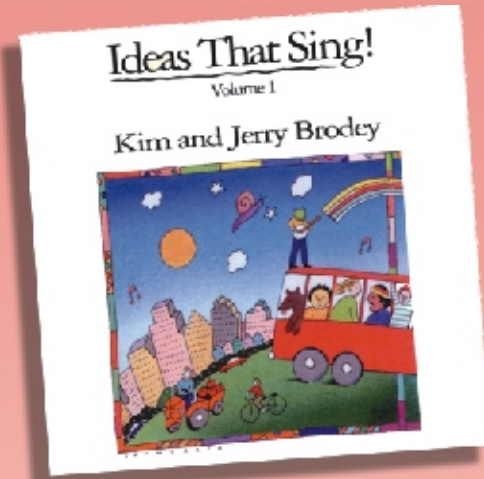
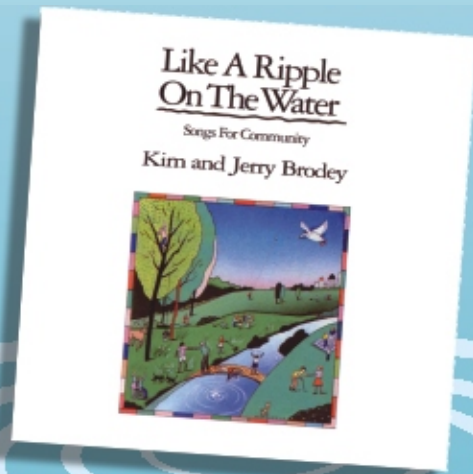

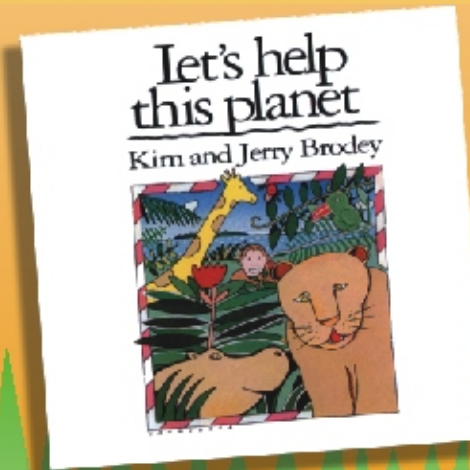
Let's Help This Planet

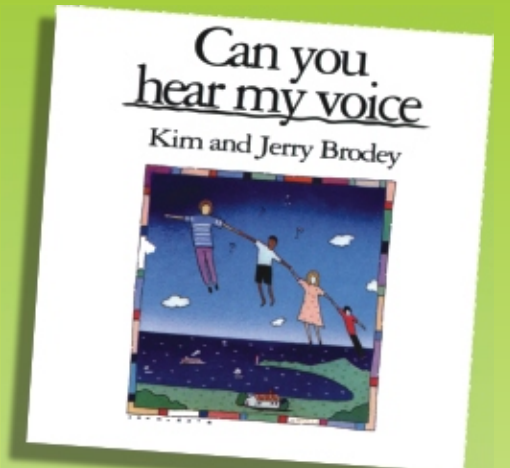

Kim and Jerry use humour, rap, storytelling, songs and theatre to explore what it's like to step into another person's shoes. Their blend of original music and theatre takes the students on a journey exploring the issues of diversity, inclusion, ability, trust, violence, name-calling and conflict resolution. In one sketch, Kim and Jerry act out a nasty fight between two school-aged friends that seems hopeless until the schoolyard peacemakers come to their rescue. In other scenes, their wonderful and lovable characters Gertrude, Alphonse and Beulah add humour and heart.
